What does the women's shelter offer?

Protection and a safe accomodation.

Counseling (if necessary with the help of interpreters) and support in all kind of questions concerning the new living situation.

Help with the clarification of the financial situation, with administrative procedures and with finding accommodation.

Peace to develop new perspectives.

Help in coming to terms with the experience of violence.

Who can come to the women's shelter?

Any woman over 18 years of age affected by physical or psychological violence and her children.

Income, religious affiliation and nationality play no role.

How does the admission to the women's shelter take place?

At any time of day or night: a phone call and a brief description of the situation is enough.

During office hours the social workers are directly available.

Outside these times, admission is replaced by the on-call service of the women's shelter.

How is life in a women's shelter organized?

Each woman lives in her own room and is responsible for herself and her children. Kitchens, bathrooms and living rooms are shared by the residents.

What you should bring to the women's shelter?

- Very important: identity card or passport
- If available: birth certificate, marriage certificate
- Other documents: Notifications of benefits, health insurance card, account card, savings book, income tax card, social security card
- Personal items: clothing, medication

And for the children

- Birth certificate, passport
- Vaccination passport/preventive booklet
- Favourite toys
- School supplies
- possibly medicines

Even if these things cannot be brought along, you are welcome!

BISS

Counseling and intervention center for domestic violence

The Counseling Center »BISS«

- is a contact point for women affected by mental or physical violence, separation or relationship problems
- offers support for victims of domestic violence if the police have ordered that the perpetrator may no longer enter the apartment (eviction)
- gives information about the possibilities of the Protection against Violence Act
- offers support in the cooperation with lawyers and courts
- works anonymously and free of charge
- offers advice if you are persecuted or harassed by an (ex-)partner (stalking)
